

Describing people

A descriptive composition about a person should consist of

- ❖ An introduction where you give brief information about the person (her Name/time or place you met ;how you heard about her/him).
- ❖ A main body where you describe physical appearance ,personality characteristics and hobbies/interests/everyday activities in separate paragraphs .
- ❖ A conclusion which includes your comments and/or feelings about the person . such descriptions can be found in articles, letters,witness statements, novel,s etc.

Points to consider in writing a descriptive composition :

- Each paragraph starts with a topic sentence which introduces the subject of the paragraph. A variety of linking words should be used to connect ideas.
- To describe physical appearance , details should be given as follow : height /build,age,facial features,hair,clothes.
- Variety in the use of adjectives will make your description more interesting.
- Avoid beginning all sentences in the same way as this will make your composition boring .
