After months of training with astronauts as backup for Japanese businessman Daisuke Enomoto, who was supposed to be the world's fourth "space tourist," Anousheh Ansari was called to take his spot aboard Soyuz TMA-9 capsule after being disqualified from flying due to a health concern. Though unaffiliated with any space agency, Ansari officially became the first woman to fly to space in September of 2006. But Ansari's journey to space began long before that launch.

When she was a young girl, Ansari drew a picture of a rocket ship and told everyone that one day, she would board a rocket just like it and fly into space, because she was not only a girl but also living in a country that didn't even have a space program — the Iranian Space Agency wasn't established until 2004 — no one truly believed she'd do it. So she set out to prove them wrong, and that's exactly what she did. Two years before she rocketed to space, Ansari and her family — who own and operate tech company Prodea Systems — awarded \$10 million to the first winner of the Ansari X Prize for successfully sending an individual spacecraft into suborbital space twice within five days. Ansari would have given anything to have been in that rocket as it left Earth's bounds.

Two years later, she was climbing aboard the International Space Station alongside Russian cosmonaut Mikhail Tyurin and NASA astronaut Michael Lopez-Alegria. "The experience really helps you see the world differently, and you re-prioritize what is important to you," Ansari told Space.com. "Your relationship with everyone and everything around you changes, and you have less stress over mundane things."
